Gentlemen:

As you know, my wife Wendy and I were recruited into Amway by trusted friends in 1984. We worked at a feverish pace and built the Amway business to the Diamond qualification in 1990. We participated in and recruited many others into the Amway business and the Haugen/Wilson motivational organization for several reasons. The business itself, its founders, management and our upline appeared on the surface to be pillars of integrity and character.

Events of the past years, which you are well aware of, have revealed a great deal about the company and people I once held in the highest esteem. Alticor, Amway, Quixtar and many of the leaders associated with it appear to be totally devoid of either integrity or character. You should have witnessed on video, or at least should know of my shock to learn and document the crimes that I discovered and know now this "business" may be the most wholly corrupt, morally bankrupt organization that I know in America.

The documentation seems to support the fact that both Quixtar and its in-house legal staff are actively engaged in fraud, silencing and threatening victims and the manipulation of counsels causing corruption of the legal process. The actions that are now well documented may lead to disbarment and severe sanctions of one or more attorneys. Through research and networking, I have learned that Amway has systematically defrauded and wiped out many people at the Emerald level and above.

It appears that I am at a crossroads now. On one hand, my purpose seems to be to inform and warn the public of the criminal activity behind all the honest looking smiles and the underhanded tactics behind the professional appearance. Perhaps Robert Blakey was not far off at all in his comparison of Amway to the Mafia. My experience and circumstances seem to confirm that analysis. It would seem appropriate to release a condensed version of what has been done to us through multiple web sites, distribution lists and main stream media outlets. The digital media and documentation, from an XDiamond's perspective and presented by professionals should be of great interest to anyone looking into Amway or Quixtar worldwide. It would be of greater interest, I'm sure, to all the unfortunate who relied on tainted counsel of their own that suppressed their case, opening new doors of suspicion, questions and discovery.

At the same time, due to my concern for Wendy, my wife and my children. I owe it to them to at least try to move on with our life. I have agreed with her to negotiate for an end and she named a settlement amount of "what we would have made if this had been fair". average the last 5 years total income (Quixtar and tool/function) and multiply it by 25 years. Then if you are within \$728,000 of that number, it will be accepted.
