**Re: Violation of Court Protective Order at
www.amquix.info/blakey.html**

Dear Sir or Madam:

We represent the Amway Corporation ("Amway") in its intellectual property matters.

Our client, Amway, is and has been involved in lengthy pending litigation matters with Proctor & Gamble ("P&G") in federal courts in Utah, Michigan, and Texas. On June 12, 1998, Judge Vanessa Gilmore of the United States District Court for the Southern District of Texas signed a Protective Order in the Texas case, Proctor & Gamble v. Amway, Cause No. H-97-2384. The Protective Order protects confidential information produced during discovery during the case. A copy of the Court's Protective Order is enclosed for your inspection.

During the course of this litigation, P&G solicited opinions of G. Robert Blakey as a possible expert witness. The results of those opinions form the Blakey report. Both of the parties, Amway and P&G, agree that this report is confidential and covered under Paragraph 2 of the Protective Order.

It has recently come to our attention that a copy of this report is posted at one of your server's websites, www.amquix.info operated by Scott Larsen. We have contacted Mr. Larsen and requested that the report be removed from the website. Mr. Larsen has failed to comply with our request.

It is our opinion that Mr. Larsen is in violation of 1st-Amendment.Net's Acceptable Use Policy (AUP). Specifically, Mr. Larsen's publication of the confidential Blakey report is unlawful and objectionable. In order to comply with both the Court's order and your Computing Policy, we ask that you either take down all of Mr. Larsen's webpage(s) containing the Blakey report, including, but not limited to www.amquix.info/blakey.html and www.amquix.info/pdfs/Blakely_expert_report.pdf, or suspend Mr. Larsen's website www.amquix.info until all webpage(s) containing the Blakey report are removed.


